

Community Payback & Surveyor's Land – pt. 1

Alan has spoken to Megan and I spoke to Ant, both of Community Payback team.

They've told Alan they want to start work on Surveyor's Land on 6th January 2026.

I discussed with Ant clearing scrub and planting our hedge (see picture – anywhere between the red lines).

Alan and Megan have discussed them clearing the scrub on the other side of the Bridleway (where the Christmas trees are to be planted) – see pictures.

Considerations for approval at next week's meeting, 19th November:

- Check we have enough canes & tree guards – **approve ordering any necessary**
- **Approve ordering of toilet**
- If they are clearing the main area of scrub, it makes sense to order Christmas trees now – **approve ordering as per Nick's original idea**



Community Payback & Surveyor's Land – pt. 2

There are a lot of fallen trees which will need to be cleared – see pictures for examples. These will need to be cleared before Payback team can start work.

A ramp needs to be created from the Bridleway (top picture) to allow a path through woods – estimate size..

Once cleared, MOT type 2 surface needs to be installed – estimate amount and cost..

Route for path has been traced (see maps) but has limitations

- A **lot** of fallen trees in the way
- For some reason app thinks I went other side of road!?!?
- There is a large pit which will need to be fenced off – suggest dead hedge using cuttings – cost of stakes for this?..
- Maps need joining together – I strayed into farmer's land on main one
